My Declaration Over the Body of Christ

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Mark 11:23

Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee... Job 22:28

God, my confession of faith¹ for the body of Christ is that each believer is baptized with the Holy Ghost² and fulfills God's plan for their life.

I claim that every believer walks in divine protection,³ receives all their inheritance in Christ Jesus,⁴ and walks in divine prosperity and good health.⁵

I say that no believer will die prematurely;⁶ and that no harm, hurt, or evil tidings come to any of my brothers or sisters in the body of Christ.⁷

I declare that not one Christian fail or fall, but that each one finish their course.8

I decree that each believer sees how valuable they are⁹ and that they have an important part in building Your kingdom.

As a member of the body of Christ, I say in Jesus' Name that we all speak the same thing; that there is no division or schism among us¹⁰ and that none of us gossips or sows discord among the brethren.¹¹

I decree that we all get along with one another, are always in one accord, 12 and that there is no strife, jealousy, envy or disharmony among us. 13

I say that we don't argue, fuss, fight, or do anything that would grieve the Holy Spirit.¹⁴

God, it's Your will that the body of Christ grow and develop spiritually, 15 walk in Your perfect will 16 and prefer and love one another. 17 I say in Jesus' Name that we esteem each member, 18 and show no partiality to one another. 19

I thank You that You help us to bear the infirmities of the weak,²⁰ and restore any who have been overtaken in a fault or sin.²¹ God, if there's anything that I can ever do to help anybody in the body of Christ (other than praying, interceding and speaking the Word over them), I thank You that You reveal it to me.²²

God, Jesus is coming back for a glorious church without spot or wrinkle.²³ Until He comes to catch us up, I praise You that we are fulfilling the Great Commission²⁴ and that the gifts of the Holy Spirit operate through the church,²⁵ and we've developed in the fruits of the spirit.²⁶ I thank You that You are confirming Your Word with signs following in the body of Christ,²⁷ in the Name of Jesus.²⁸

Prayer adapted from Ephesians 1:16-23 & Ephesians 3:14-21

I Cease not to give thanks for the body of Christ, making mention of them in my prayers; That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto each believer the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him:

The eyes of their understanding being enlightened; that they may know what is the hope of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, And what *is* the exceeding greatness of His power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of His mighty power,

Which He wrought in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and set *Him* at His own right hand in the heavenly *places*, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

And hath put all *things* under His feet, and gave Him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church, Which is His body, the fulness of Him that filleth all in all.

For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, That He would grant the body of Christ, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man;

That Christ may dwell in each believer's heart by faith; that they, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that they might be filled with all the fulness of God.

Now unto Him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, Unto Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
