Dear Friend and Partner,

Jesus said in Mark 11:22-24: Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

These are verses of scripture that we can use to remove mountains in our life, as well as pray and receive from God whatever we desire. Faith in God works. And when one's faith is not producing, they have a tendency to become discouraged and lose faith in God. But God Gave us the Word, and His Word never fails.

God said in 3 John 2: **Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.** It's God's desire that each one of His children prospers and lives in good health. Jesus took all our poverty, sickness, and disease, **as well as sins** when He went to the cross. We're told to fight the good fight of faith in 1 Timothy 6:12, and part of that faith fight is casting down imaginations that come to our mind (2 Cor. 10:5).

Satan is our enemy, and he comes to steal, kill and destroy (John 10:10). He'll do all he can to discourage us from believing God and holding fast to our confession on faith. Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompense of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry. Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. Hebrews 10:23, 35-38

Get a confession of faith and hold it fast; don't relinquish it or give up. You want the sword of the spirit, the Word of God, coming out of your mouth 24/7 (Joshua 1:8). Jesus Christ defeated Satan and gave us His Name to use in dealing with the devil (Philippians 2:9-11).

Your wellbeing, finances, sound mind and good health are very important. As a believer, you want to stay financially prosperous, emotionally and mentally stable, and healthy physically. But it is *up to you* to stay strong in God's Word. So, start every day reading God's promises, because problems and trouble won't leave you if you allow your spiritual life to become weak. You have to make mountains and problems leave your life by using your spiritual authority in Jesus' Name and by speaking to them. Guard your mind from depression; guard your heart from doubt and unbelief, and make yourself do the Word every day (James 1:22).

Enclosed is a prayer card entitled, I'm Debt Free and Prosperous! If you are faced with any kind of financial debt or challenges, I want to encourage you to use this card. Read it out loud several times a day, if necessary. Attack lack, poverty and debt with God's promises in Jesus' Name. Jesus spoke the Word, and you want to do so, as well. Jesus resisted the devil, and so should you (Matthew 4:1-11, James 4:7, 1 Peter 5:8,9, Mark 16:17). Be faithful to put God's Word first in your life, and keep it there. Be a faithful tither and giver to the gospel, and always put God first every day in your life (Matthew 6:33).
