God's Children Aren't Poor

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth. 3 John 2

And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life. Mark 10:29,30

Soon after I was born again by receiving Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior, someone loaned me some faith teaching tapes. The tapes were on divine prosperity and the hundredfold return. I was very much impressed by the teaching, because the minister spoke with so much authority. It was implanted in me that I could believe that the written Word of God was <u>God speaking to me personally</u>, and what the Word said was His will for my life.

I thought the coolest word I heard was the word "prosperity". I also liked the fact that you could receive a hundredfold return on your giving. I became so excited and enthusiastic about God's Word that I began to tell anyone that would listen to me that God wanted them financially prosperous and that God would give us a hundredfold return on our giving to the gospel.

I thought everybody would get excited too, but to my dismay, I was getting precious few to accept or believe what I was sharing from the Word of God. I showed them 3 John 2 and Mark 10:29 & 30 from the Bible. Just the idea that you no longer had to be poor and live in lack and poverty, **and** knowing that when you gave to God's work to help build His kingdom, He would bless you back in this lifetime a hundredfold return on your giving, was so exciting!

God's Eternal, Living Word

If a believer will not accept their inheritance, they limit God in working in their life and on their behalf. You cannot take scriptures out of God's Word and think you've eliminated them, for they are eternal. What God said, He will never alter, withdraw, or change. Once He has spoken His Word, once He has made a promise, it is *forever*.

Jesus said in John 6:63, It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they

are spirit, and they are life.

God said in Isaiah 55:11, So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

The Bible says in Matthew 4:4, **But he answered and said, It is** written, **Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.**

Prosperity is Yours!

Prosperity is one of the benefits you have in your New Covenant. It's always been there since the day God made a covenant with mankind, and it will always be part of your Covenant.

Some believers are not prospering because of ignorance. Hosea 4:6 says, My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

Others have heard the Word, but have failed to act upon prosperity scriptures. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. James 1:22

And others, because of religious teaching, have rejected prosperity and have allied themselves with poverty and lack. Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye. Mark 7:13

Two Things You Need to Do to Prosper

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. Joshua 1:8

My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. <u>Let them not depart from thine eyes</u>; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. Proverbs 4:20-22

There are a lot of things that God could have told Joshua to do that would have been good and beneficial for him to do. But for

Joshua to prosper and have good success, he was required to do two things:

#1. He had to keep the Word of God in his mouth. He couldn't say anything other than what God's Word said.

#2. He was required to meditate on the Word day and night.

What Makes God Move

You have got to <u>first</u> persuade yourself that God wants you to be prosperous, and until you get that accomplished, you will never have divine prosperity. You may experience some financial miracles and breakthroughs, but never realize what caused them to happen. You'll think yourself, 'I wonder what I did to get God to move. I wonder how I can get Him to move like that again'. But we must realize that God is <u>not</u> a hit and miss God (meaning, sometimes He moves and other times He doesn't).

The thing that makes God move in our lives and causes His blessings to manifest is that we believe His Word and act upon His Word. This has to be a constant, continually acting upon God's Word. And, the only way we can do that is by always having the Word in our mouth and always thinking about what the Word says. You cannot talk about how expensive everything is getting and, at the same time, act on God's Word and believe His promises.

Whatsoever You Say will Come to Pass

Up until the time I got those faith tapes, I had always talked poverty and lack, and I was having what I was saying and believing. Jesus said in Mark 11:23, For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall <u>say</u> unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he <u>saith</u> shall come to pass; he shall <u>have</u> whatsoever he <u>saith</u>.

If you're talking the curse of poverty and lack, you're going to experience it. If you're talking prosperity and abundant life, you'll experience *that*. You may think that what you say is not important, or that you can talk any way you want to talk as long as you're not saying swear words. You may think you're getting by thinking that way without being harmed, or that you are not harming yourself with what you say. But the reason you think that way is because your mind is not renewed to God's Word. Your mind is darkened and you haven't received any revelation knowledge of God's Word or on the subject of words – *your words* – *your personal words*.

Once you receive revelation knowledge of God's Word on any given subject in the Word, your mind and your heart are illuminated with light. This is because the entrance of God's Word brings light (Ps. 119:130). And, you can be a born again child of God, doing your best to serve and please God, and at the same time, walk in darkness and use your mouth against yourself.

Other than Jesus Christ, the richest, most prosperous and wisest man who ever lived was Solomon, and he said in Proverbs 6: 2, Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth.

A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. Proverbs 18: 20,21

And Jesus said,... whosoever shall ...believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Mark 11:23

But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. Matthew 12:36,37

We were born again through speaking words. (That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Romans 10:9,10)

Have You Received the Holy Ghost since You Believed?

One of the initial signs we have that we believers have been filled with the Holy Spirit is that we speak in tongues as the Spirit gives us utterance. Satan is after our words. Once a believer gets into the Word of God and begins to act on the Word by speaking the Word, Satan begins to lose control of their life.

And, when a believer begins to pray in the Holy Ghost, which is praying in tongues, they begin to build themselves up spiritually (Jude 20). It seems so many believers have a difficult time believing they have what they say, and that speaking in tongues would do any good.

But if a believer does not take charge of their circumstances by using their spiritual authority and exercising the dominion God gave them, by using their words to change things and create things, they end up being dominated and controlled by their own circumstances. And if a believer doesn't keep themselfs built up in the Holy Ghost through ping in the Spirit, they limit the work of the Holy Spirit in their life.

For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people. To whom he said, This is the rest wherewith ye may cause the weary to rest; and this is the refreshing: yet they would not hear. Isaiah 28:11,12

Too many believers do not discipline their manner of speech. And too few pray in tongues. You can't control your tongue in the natural, but you can fill your heart with God's Word. And pray in the Holy Ghost enough that you'll get so that you're only speaking what pleases God and edifies You.

Now, are you going to dispute Solomon? He was so wealthy, he'd make Donald Trump look like a beggar! And God is so rich, He makes all men look like they never existed, because God paved His streets with gold and made His walls out of jasper, and His gates of pearls (Revelation 21:18, 21). How could any child of God ever think, ever entertain the thought, "Why have the best when the other will do?"

What God Did for One, He'll Do for You

Opening his mouth, Peter said: "I most certainly understand now that God is not one to show partiality... Acts 10:34

We don't talk to our needs-we talk the Word and what it says about the needs. We're not in denial. The problems exist. We just refuse and deny poverty and lack to rule, control and manipulate us.

We're the children of God, and we are to be the wealthiest people of this world like Solomon, So king Solomon exceeded all the kings of the earth for riches and for wisdom (1 Kings 10:23); like David, Thus David the son of Jesse reigned over all Israel. And he died in a good old age, full of days, riches, and honour: and Solomon his son reigned in his stead (1 Chronicles 29:26,28); like Abraham, And Abram was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold (Genesis 13:2); and like Job, So the LORD blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning: for he had fourteen thousand sheep, and a thousand camels, and a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand she asses (Job 42:12).

We should prosper as they did or more, because we have the same God they had, plus a better covenant (**But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry**, **by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.** Hebrews 8:6). We are to be living in a surplus of abundance, possessing enough financial blessings that we require no aid or support from anyone but God!

(2 Corinthians 9:8 AMP)

For the scripture says in 2 Corinthians 8:9, For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

[Remember] this: he who sows sparingly and grudgingly will also reap sparingly and grudgingly, and he who sows generously [that blessings may come to someone] will also reap generously and with blessings.

Let each one [give] as he has made up his own mind and purposed in his heart, not reluctantly or sorrowfully or under compulsion, for God loves (He takes pleasure in, prizes above other things, and is unwilling to abandon or to do without) a cheerful (joyous, "prompt to do it") giver [whose heart is in his giving].

And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].

As it is written, He [the benevolent person] scatters abroad; He gives to the poor; His deeds of justice and goodness and kindness and benevolence will go on and endure forever!

And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for]

sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness [which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity].

Thus you will be enriched in all things and in every way, so that you can be generous, and [your generosity as it is] administered by us will bring forth thanksgiving to God. 2 Corinthians 9:6-11 AMP

Poverty is not a Blessing

And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save thee. Deuteronomy 28:29

When I was a child (I don't remember exactly how old I was), there was a family that lived next door to us. They were the Ellises and they had four children: David, Chuckie, Peggy and Susie. One day, Mrs. Ellis was walking to the grocery store, and she stopped to talk to my mother. She said, "Helen (that's my mother), we don't have any groceries in the house. I told my husband the children are hungry and need something to eat, and we only have a dollar. Helen, what am I supposed to get with a dollar to feed four children?"

She walked all the way to EV's grocery store and all the way home. I waited to see what she had gotten as she passed by our house. She'd bought a box of Cornflakes. They had no milk, and there wasn't the Welfare then that we have today. And that's all those kids had to eat. My mother cried as she told my dad what had happened.

I've always hated poverty, as I'm sure you do, too. I hate to see a mother with children not adequately taken care of. But the good news is Luke 4:18,19:

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

Having a Prosperous Mind

For prosperity to become a reality in our lives, we must renew our minds to God's Word so that we become single-minded, Word-minded, New Covenant-minded and no longer double-minded. We have to get to where we see ourselves prosperous and fully persuaded and we're acting accordingly. You can say you're prosperous according to the Word, but if you act in lack or in poverty, you'll nullify your confession of faith. James said in James 2:17, 20, Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? You can't talk faith and doubt and unbelief. You can't talk about how big God is, and in the next breath, how expensive gasolene is! Sweet water and bitter water cannot come out of the same faucet.

Wealth Without Peace

In the theater district of New York City, and all over Manhattan,

in a short time, you can see hundreds of chaffered limousines and apartments that would go for 20 to \$30 million, celebrity people, millionaires, and Wall Street tycoons. Many of them have become financially successful and prosperous. I've talked to some of them personally. Some have been quick to say how successful they were. They use the principles that are in this world. These principles have worked for them, and these people have accumulated vast sums of wealth.

But if they don't have Jesus in their heart, they have no peace, even though they have seemingly everything that this world has to offer. They did what the world told them to do to get what they wanted, but at the end of the road, they just couldn't get enough. They couldn't satisfy their need. Only Jesus in your heart can do that, rich **or** poor.

One can also become prosperous in this world by doing what the devil tells them to do, such as doing things that are dishonest, like selling drugs, as well as taking advantage of others. A person can get wealthy that way, but have no peace, For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? (Matthew 16:26)

But the good news is God made a Covenant with His people and in that Covenant is divine prosperity. God is your Father, and He wants you to be financially prosperous and have the peace of God at the same time.

Why does God want you financially prosperous?

<u>First</u>, because you're His child and He wants you blessed! Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth (3 John 2).

<u>Second</u>, He wants you to establish His Covenant here on this earth, for He said in Deuteronomy 8:18, **But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God:** for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.

<u>Third</u>, God wants you to use your prosperity to be a blessing to others, for He said in Ephesians 4:28, Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.

Fourth, we are to be a testimony to others of what God can do with an individual who will stand upon His Word and believe it, who will walk and live by faith, who will not waver or wonder, but will stay on course. And she said to the king, It was a true report that I heard in mine own land of thy acts and of thy wisdom. Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard. 1 Kings 10:6,7

Your Faith Challenge

I want to ask you to do some things. First of all, I want you to tell as many people as you can every day that you are prosperous

and say it with passion and conviction. I want you to read the prosperity scriptures on pages 5 & 6 several times a day, and I want you to rise up in the morning speaking the Word and talking it all day long. Let it be the last thing you say before you fall asleep.

4Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: 5And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. 6And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: 7And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. 8And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. 9And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates. 10And it shall be, when the LORD thy God shall have brought thee into the land which he sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give thee great and goodly cities, which thou buildedst not, 11And houses full of all good things, which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full; Deuteronomy 6:4-12

Every time you do something for the gospel, say, "Thank God for my hundredfold return, in Jesus' Name". This is going to help you renew your mind to God's Word, as well as help you keep God's Word in your mouth and in your heart. Plus, it will be a living witness to others that our God is a prosperous God.

You and I, as partners together, can get the Word of God out to this world and preach the gospel to the poor so they don't have to be poor anymore. My mother cooked many meals for those children and gave food to other families, and fed other children. Somehow, God always took care of us. She believed and taught us boys that it's more blessed to give - and you know, <u>it is!</u>

When you're blessed, you can bless others. God has blessed us, as His children, and has given us the responsibility of reaching the world. And you know we can, because we can do all things through Christ (Philippians 4:13). So take a stand and receive the divine prosperity and wealth that belongs to you as a believer and go forth and be a blessing to others every day.

Remember the Words of our Lord Jesus Christ when He said, I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly (John 10:10). It's Satan who doesn't want you to prosper. He's a thief and he's the destroyer (John 10:10). He comes to take the Word out (Mark 4:15). He brings all the trials to get you to back off the Word, to get you to give up and quit. But you resist the devil by speaking the Word and acting accordingly to it and go forth in this world ruling in reigning in Christ Jesus (James 4:7).
