Dear Friend and Partner,

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly. John 10:10

For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich. 2 Corinthians 8:9

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth. 3 John 2

Divine prosperity belongs to each and every born-again child of God; it's part of the believer's inheritance in the New Covenant. It is a blessing and not a curse. And, it's a benefit that carries an awesome responsibility along with it. As the apostle Paul, inspired by Holy Spirit, said in 1 Timothy 6:17 - 19,

Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate; Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

And, we are warned in Proverbs 1:32, **For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them.**

It's very important, in your walk of faith and spiritual growth and development, that you take the time to renew your mind to God's Word to the point that you can believe in your heart that your Father God wants you to prosper and be successful in every area of your life.

You need to be able to cast down all feelings of being undeserving and unworthy that cause you to think, 'why have the best when the other will do?' In any area that you allow doubt, fear, worry,

unbelief, double-mindedness, or feelings of unworthiness to creep in, it will hinder and affect you in other areas of your Christian life.

What God has required of us is that we believe His Word and act as though it's true. We need to obey Him and always put Him first, and always remember to be thankful for everything He's done for us. Remember that all of our blessings and every good thing we have come from Him:

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning. James 1:17

But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for *it is he* that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as *it is* this day. Deuteronomy 8:18

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Matthew 6:33

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. Philippians 4:6

It's easy to be influenced by the world's news of the economy, as it is to be affected by the cultish false doctrine that poverty is godly. The usual reasons that a believer does not prosper financially are that they're too lazy to work, use and develop the talents that God gave them. Or, they think that they're pleasing God by going without. They refuse to fight the good fight of faith and stand against poverty, (one of the curses of the broken law**), or they're just scripturally ignorant of what belongs to them in their New Covenant through Christ Jesus.

**Some curses of the broken law are:

Thou shalt carry much seed out into the field, and shalt gather *but* little in; for the locust shall consume it. Thou shalt plant vineyards, and dress *them*, but shalt neither drink *of* the wine, nor gather *the grapes*; for the worms shall eat them.

The stranger that *is* within thee shall get up above thee very high; and thou shalt come down very low. He shall lend to thee, and thou shalt not lend to him: he shall be the head, and thou shalt be the tail.

Because thou servedst not the LORD thy God with joyfulness, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all *things*; Therefore shalt thou serve thine enemies which the LORD shall send against thee, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in want of all *things*: and he shall put a yoke of iron upon thy neck, until he have destroyed thee.

Deuteronomy 28:38,39;43,44;47&48

In order for a believer to prosper financially, they need to renew their mind to God's Word. This comes about by confessing prosperity scriptures daily and meditating on them day and night, casting down every thought that is contrary to the Word of God, and diligently seeking the Lord for wisdom and guidance in the affairs of this life.

Receiving prosperity is like receiving divine healing. You have to purpose in your heart that it is for you, and you cannot be bogged down in your walk of faith by those who go without (for whatever their reason may be). Just as there are a 'gazillion' people who haven't received divine healing, there will be that many or more, who don't receive divine prosperity.

You cannot allow the misfortunes of others keep you from inheriting the promises of God. You will have to be determined and take the bold stand that you will not compromise or permit poverty and lack to stay in your life. Though as believers, we will all be faced with temptations, tests and trials, the Lord will get us through every one of them if we will not waver in faith.

As long as a person copes with poverty and lack, they'll always have it. But once a believer gains the knowledge and revelation of God's Word and builds their spirit man up with those promises, faithfully obeying the Lord, there will be nothing that Satan can do to prevent them from prospering. God will permit us to live in poverty, just as

He will permit us to live in sin and sickness –it's just not His will.

Jesus tells a story of three individuals in Matthew 25, verse 14-30:

For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods. And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents. And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two. But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money. After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more. His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them. His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed: And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine. His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed: Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.

Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents. For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath. And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

For us to live in divine prosperity, we first have to believe that

it is God's will, and secondly, we have to act like we are what the Word of God says we are. This is what pleases our heavenly Father.

Before I got saved, I had a job installing floor covering. I went to church every Sunday, and was very religious, but I didn't know Jesus as my Lord and Savior.

One day, I was scheduled to carpet the parsonage of a pastor. His house was beautifully decorated with very expensive furnishings. It made me very angry that a minister lived this way, and I let him know that I totally disagreed with his lavish lifestyle. What made me even angrier is that he didn't try to explain to me, or reason or argue with me, or give me some excuse as to why he had these things.

Instead, he said something that seemed to penetrate my heart, and I never got over it. He said something to the effect of, "Son, how is it that you'd want me to live? And, if I got rid of all these things, would you follow Jesus?" His words seemed to melt my heart.

I'm not too sure why I said what I did to him -- maybe I was just jealous and envious. There seems to be no one more opinionated than a religious person.

But, blessings and prosperity come from the Lord, and should be received and not resisted, simply because the Lord loves His children and just wants to bless them. Satan does not want the body of Christ to walk in victory or live as over-comers, or to walk in divine health or prosperity...nor do many people, when it comes to receiving all that God has for you!

I want to encourage you to begin to look to God as your Great Provider. If you find yourself becoming discouraged in your walk of faith because the tests and trials seem severe, just make yourself keep doing what the Word of God teaches you to do, such as:

- walk in love,
- be led by the Holy Ghost,
- forgive others who have wronged you,

- repent of any sin or wrongdoing that went unconfessed,
- fervently, and earnestly pray for others, and
- help God build His kingdom by faithfully tithing and giving to the gospel.

Just keep on thanking and praising God and rejoicing in the Lord that:

- every need is met in abundance and that the windows of heaven are opened up to you,
- that God is pouring out blessings to you,
- that the devil is bound from your finances,
- that every bill is paid, in Jesus' Name, and
- that God wishes above all things that you prosper.

Do not give up or quit; feed your faith every day on the promises of God, and every day, spend time on your knees, lifting your hands and sacrificing praises and thanksgiving unto the Lord. The Lord will never fail to come through, nor will He ever let you down. For, as the psalmist said in Psalm 37:25, I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

Speaking the Word Over Your Finances

Speaking the Word of God over your finances helps you in several ways. For one thing, it renews your mind to God's Word. This is where we will have some of the biggest battles in our Christian life, because that's where much of the doubt, fear, and unbelief enter in, as read in 2 Corinthians 10:4, 5: **(For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;**

One way that we're able to renew our mind to God's Word and resist the devil is by constantly meditating on the Word of God and speaking it out of our mouths. We need to speak scriptures like the following:

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. Joshua 1:8

Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant. Psalms 35:27

By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. Hebrews 13:15

If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. John 15:7

As many times as possible during the day, when thoughts come to you about your finances, just say out loud to yourself, "*God wishes above all things that I prosper and be in health, even as my soul prospers.*" This will help build up your spirit man, help you to become fully persuaded that prosperity is God's will for you, and it will help you resist negative thoughts from the enemy. We've got to persuade ourselves, as believers, that the promises of God are God's will for us.

After I got saved, I learned God wanted His people to be prosperous and in good health, and I shared those verses of scripture with many believers. But I had a very difficult time believing it was God's will for me. In the long run, the difficulty I had in the beginning later became a blessing to help me realize that when I'm doubting God and His Word, I'm behind in faith. When we are behind in faith, we are in unbelief. It's then that we need to get ourselves busy with our confession of faith and get ourselves built back up.

In the natural, it's no fun on your flesh to try to lose weight after you gain it. Well, your carnal nature doesn't enjoy quoting the promises of God all day long in order for you to get yourself built back up to where you're not sinking in doubt and unbelief.

To help you, I'm including a prayer and a confession of faith based on God's Word to use to exercise your authority over the devil, as well as scriptures to read out loud daily. Use all of the resources in this newsletter, and never give up believing God and trusting His promises!

I want to encourage you to keep on standing and not give up, for God promised He'd come through for you in His Word. Now, I want to pray for you.

My Prayer for You:

God, I come to You today in Jesus' Name to agree with my dear brother and sister in the Lord. We're partners together in the work of God. But most of all, we're Your children, and You said You wish above all things that Your children prosper and be in health

(3 John 2).

So, we settle for nothing less than divine prosperity, and I agree with them that every one of their bills is paid, in Jesus' Name. For You said in Matthew 18:19, **Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.**

God, they're Your children. They're tithers, givers, and they're partners together with me in getting Your Word out to all the world. You said You'd supply all their need, according to Your riches in glory, by Christ Jesus. You said in Malachi 3:10-12, **Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.**
