

God Wants to Lead You Himself...not Anyone Else

Romans 9:1: I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,

Galatians 1:16: To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood:

Galatians 2:2: And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.

1 Corinthians 2:10-14: But God hath revealed *them* unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.

God is not going to want someone else guiding you, because if they're able to do that, they'll control you. That always ends up being cultish and devilish. He sent the Holy Spirit to be your guide. In the Old Testament, people were led by fleeces, prophecies and prophets. But the Holy Spirit, Who spoke through those prophets in the Old Testament and gave them visions and dreams, dwells in each believer today.

It's unscriptural in your New Covenant to seek for a word from somebody, or seek out a confirmation. Seek God for yourself in His Word and in prayer.

James 4:7,8: Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you...

As we submit ourselves to God and His Word, and draw nigh to Him through reading His Word, meditating on His Word, doing His Word, practicing His Word, and acting on the revelation we receive from His Word and the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we'll be able to fulfill His perfect will for our life. This should be the heart's desire of every believer: to please our Father God, as Jesus did.

John 5:19: Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

John 6:38: For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

Remember that God wishes above all things that you prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers (3 John 2).
