

## Guidelines and Scriptures to Help You Walk in Love, and be Led by the Holy Spirit

### Here are 3 steps to take in being led by the Holy Spirit.

**Number One:** Read the New Testament every day. Put time in studying the Word. **Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.** 2 Timothy 2:15

**Number Two:** Spend time praying in the Holy Ghost, which is praying in tongues. You'll notice the more you pray in the spirit, the more sensitive you'll be to the Holy Spirit. **But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.** Jude 20, 21

**Number Three:** Always obey the inward witness. **I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,** Romans 9:1

- Instead of judging people you think are wrong, just keep praying that their eyes be opened and they come to themselves.
- Whether you feel like it or not, stay with the Word.
- Make yourself fellowship with other believers of like precious faith, make yourself love everyone, and do what the Word says to do.
- Anything that you think is the Holy Spirit, judge it in line with the Word. If it contradicts the New Testament, it's not God; it's not the Holy Spirit. It's a familiar spirit. The devil is a deceiver, and he'll try to deceive the very elect. That means YOU. But even though there is deception, don't let that hinder you from stepping out for God.

I'd like to give you the following scriptures to read and become familiar with and mark in your Bible. Try to read them every day for a few days. They will help educate you and help you familiarize yourself with being led by the Holy Spirit. We all need to learn to listen to our spirit. We

can all testify and tell stories of the things we suffered and encountered when we didn't go with what we had in our heart, and missed God.

I like to think about the times I did obey God: The time He told me to go to Bible school, for two years and when I enrolled, it was only a year school. But before I graduated, it became a two year school.

Then, the Lord told me to reach New England with the Word of faith, and then when He told me to move to New York City...And then, the morning of 9/11, when He told me not to go downtown, but uptown Manhattan. I got this at 8:30 that morning, and at 8:46, I found out why. It takes faith to obey God, and that's what pleases God.

## **Scriptures to Read Our Loud Daily**

**Romans 8:14 - 16: For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:**

**Matthew 4:1: Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.**

**Luke 4:1: And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,**

**1 Thessalonians 5:23: And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

**1 John 3:20 - 23: For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, *then* have we confidence toward God. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight. And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.**

**1 Corinthians 14:2, 4, 14,15: For he that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth *him*; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries. He that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth**

edifieth the church. For if I pray in an *unknown* tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful. What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.

Jude 20: **But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,**

Romans 8:26-28: **Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what *is* the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of* God. And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose.**

Remember, God wishes above all things that you prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers (3 John 2).
