Rebuking the Devil When He Comes With Fear

I thought it would be good to share some scriptures with you to help combat and eradicate any fear that may be coming to you. Fear is an enemy and a tormenting spirit. We, as believers, must renew our minds to God's Word, as well as use the scriptures to rebuke the devil. Remember, it's important that we always cast down imaginations and rebuke fear when it comes to us. Fear is not to be played with, but instead, it is to be rebuked when it shows up. Say it this way: "Fear, I rebuke you, in Jesus' Name. Satan, it is written, For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. In Jesus' Name, I refuse fear of anything."

Fear is a real enemy. Job said, For the thing which <u>I greatly feared</u> is come upon me, and that which <u>I was afraid</u> of is come unto me (Job 3:25). And Jesus described Men's hearts failing them <u>for fear</u>, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth (Luke 21:25).

God gave us the following verses, as a weapon against fear. Please mark them in your Bible, and if you can, print them off and place them somewhere, such as around your bathroom mirror or on your refrigerator door. When you see them, it will remind you to read them aloud.

Deuteronomy 31:8: And the LORD, he *it is* that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: <u>fear not</u>, neither be dismayed.

Psalm 23:4: Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, *I will fear no evil*: for thou *art* with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

Psalm 27:1: The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Psalm 34:4: I sought the LORD, and he heard me, and <u>delivered me from all my fears</u>.

Psalm 56:3, 4: What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee. In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; *I will not fear* what flesh can do unto me.

Psalm 112:6-8: Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance. <u>He shall not be afraid</u> of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD. His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see *his desire* upon his enemies.

Psalm 118:6: The LORD is on my side; <u>I will not fear</u>: what can man do unto me?

Proverbs 29:25: The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

Isaiah 41:10, 13: <u>Fear thou not</u>; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

Romans 8:15: For <u>ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear</u>; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

Philippians 4:6: <u>Be careful for nothing</u>; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

2 Timothy 1:7: For <u>God hath not given us the spirit of fear</u>; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Hebrews 13:5, 6: Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and <u>I will not fear</u> what man shall do unto me.

1 John 4:18: There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

Romans 5:5: And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

1 John 4:4: Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because <u>greater is</u> <u>he that is in you, than he that is in the world.</u>

Revelation 21:7, 8: He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. But the <u>fearful</u>, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
