

You Frame Your World

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear. Hebrews 11:3

The personal world you live in, and your everyday life are framed by the words of your mouth. Every single Word of faith cassette tape that's out there - every CD, every book - they were all sent your way to teach you how to talk.

I can remember like it was yesterday when somebody handed me my first set of Word of faith cassette teaching tapes. They changed my life! And you talk about getting persecuted! At the time, I didn't know that Jesus had said in Mark 10:29,30: **Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.**

When you believe God for prosperity and a hundredfold return, Satan is going to crank up the persecution. Satan uses persecution to take the Word out of you: **And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.** Mark 4:17

Satan has got to get you away from the Word, and he's got all kinds of tactics to accomplish this. Either he deceives you, or you deceive yourself, or you allow somebody else to deceive you. Either way, it all just ends up robbing you of what your Father God wants you to have.

If your prosperity were evil, it wouldn't be in the New Covenant God gave you, God would never have given you the power to get wealth (Deuteronomy 8:18), and you wouldn't have been an heir of Abraham's blessing (Galatians 3:29).

God said when we tithe, He'd open up the windows of heaven and pour us out a blessing, as we read in Malachi 3:10-12: **Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that *there shall not be room enough to receive it.* And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.**

God's will for your life, financially, is that you have too much and more than enough to take care of every financial responsibility you have.

For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich. 2 Corinthians 8:9

And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation]. 2 Corinthians 9:8 AMP

...I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly. John 10:10

God will let you live your life out without ever having enough. Or, He'll let you have just enough, but His desire is for you to have more than enough, financially.

Until you're living in abundance, so that you don't have enough room to contain all of it, you still haven't reached God's perfect will for your life, financially. Jesus purchased your financial blessings personally. He paid for them, just as He bought your healing and good health. He also purchased your righteousness for you, but it's up to you to receive all your blessings, and keep them.

Satan will do all he can to rob you of your blessings, so it's important that you keep walking in love, being led by the Holy Spirit, and resisting poverty and lack, in Jesus' Name.

Poverty, sin, sickness and Satan should all make you angry when they show up. You should become violent against them. If that stuff starts showing up, pick up your sword, the Word of God, and start speaking it out of your mouth to the devil and to his attacks. Refuse to tolerate anything that Jesus redeemed you from. God sent His Word to us, so it's our responsibility to apply it to our life.

You can do it, because you can do all things through Christ, who strengthens you (Philippians 4:13). And remember, you're more than a conqueror through Christ Jesus! (Romans 8:37). Actively practice your authority on this earth as a born again child of God!

Remember, God wishes above all things that you prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers (3 John 2).
