

Ezekiel 22:30: ... I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me...

Mark 11:23: For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Romans 4:17: (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, *even* God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.

Philippians 4:6: Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Father God, I come to You today to intercede on behalf of my son, and I thank You that he has dedicated himself to serve You all of his healthy, prosperous, victorious life, for it is You Who works in him both to will and do Your Good pleasure! I thank You for saving, healing, protecting, loving, forgiving, and delivering him.

I thank You for the Holy Spirit, Who daily guides my son and imparts wisdom to him, revealing to him the importance of following Jesus every day of his life, as well as having a personal relationship with Him. I decree that my child is a bold witness for the Lord Jesus Christ (Acts 4:31,33).

I pray that my son always knows where he is supposed to be, **and goes there**; what he's supposed to do **and does it**; who he's supposed to be with or not be with and **obeys those promptings**, because he's filled with the Holy Spirit and led by the Inward Witness (Ro. 8:14-16; 1 Jo. 5:9,10; Prov. 3:5,6). I pray that every moment of his life, he's at the right place at the right time, and if anyone or anything is in his life that is not of You, Father God, You remove those influences from my son. Thank You, God, for giving him the right friends, the right spouse and the right relationships.

I decree that my child has a hunger for God's Word and is a doer of the Word; that he grows and develops spiritually and loves You with all his heart, according to Matthew 22:37: ...**Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.** I thank You that he is redeemed from all sickness, disease, poverty and lack, and is delivered from all sins and every work of Satan.

I pray that my son always knows the difference between good and evil, and never falls into any of Satan's snares, devices or traps.

Satan, I come against you in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. I bind You from my son. You can't have him. I break your power and influence over his life, in Jesus' Name! You can't touch my child. I have authority over you, for it is written in Matthew 18:18: Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. You can't put anything on my child; you can't hurt or harm him in any way. I decree that his circumstances, body, mind and thoughts are off limits to you, in Jesus' Name!

God, wherever my son is, thank You for protecting him, for the angel of the Lord encamps around about him (Ps.34:7). I thank You for the hedge of protection around my child, which is the **91st Psalm**, and I claim it over his life as I pray the 91st Psalm for him now:

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. My son will say of the LORD, You are my refuge and my fortress: my God; in You will I trust.

Surely You shall deliver my son from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. You shall cover him with Your feathers, and under Your wings shall he trust: Your truth shall be his shield and buckler. He shall not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

A thousand may fall at his side, and ten thousand at his right hand; but it shall not come nigh my child. Only with his eyes shall he behold and see the reward of the wicked.

Because my son has made the LORD, Who is my refuge, even the most High, his habitation; There shall no evil befall him, neither shall any plague come nigh his dwelling. For God shall give His angels charge over him, to keep him in all his ways. They shall bear my son up in their hands, lest he dash his foot against a stone. My child shall tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shall he trample under feet.

Because your son has set his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he has known My Name. He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him My salvation.

Prayers Adapted from Ephesians for Your Son

I Cease not to give thanks for my son, making mention of him in my prayers; That You, the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto him the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of You: The eyes of his understanding being enlightened; that he may know what is the hope of Your calling, and what the riches of the glory of Your inheritance in the saints, And what *is* the exceeding greatness of Your power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of Your mighty power, Which You wrought in Christ, when You raised Him from the dead, and set *Him* at Your own right hand in the heavenly *places*, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

And hath put all *things* under His feet, and gave Him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church, Which is His body, the fulness of Him that filleth all in all.

For this cause I bow my knees unto You, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, That You would grant to my son, according to the riches of Your glory, to be strengthened with might by Your Spirit in the inner man; That Christ may dwell in his heart by faith; that he, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that he might be filled with all the fulness of God. Now unto You Who is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, Unto You *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

If Your Son is not Born Again:

God, I come to You today in the Name of Jesus, claiming the salvation of my son. I claim by faith that he is saved, delivered, set free and baptized in the Holy Spirit. In the Name of Jesus, I break Satan's power over his life. He will not keep my son from coming into the family of God.

Lord, You said in Your Word, **...Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven** (Matthew 18:18).

Satan, I bind you from my child's life. You'll not keep my son from receiving Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior! Jesus gave me ...power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy... You'll not keep the light of the glorious gospel of Christ from shining unto him (Luke 10:19; 2 Cor. 4:4).

Lord, I ask You to remove from my son's life any people or influences that are not supposed to be there, and that distract him from salvation.

Father God, Your Word says, **...Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house** (Acts 16:31). It is written that You **...will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth** (1 Timothy 2:4). It is written that You are **...not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance** (2 Peter 3:9).

Father, You opened Lydia's heart in Acts 16:14. I believe You will do the same for *my* son. I ask You to send Holy Spirit-led believers across his path¹ to witness to him, to tell him Words whereby he shall be saved (Acts 1:8, Acts 11:14). I pray that his eyes will be opened to the Truth as he hears Your Word!²

Thank You, Father, for creating the right circumstances for the Word to be planted in his heart. Laborers are being sent forth to minister unto him and Holy Ghost conviction is drawing him to You.

I refuse to fear; I have claimed my son for the Kingdom of God in Jesus' Name. I am standing in faith and love for him. I am not moved by what I see or feel; I am only moved by what the Word of God says. Circumstances are subject to CHANGE!³ I have God's Word and it cannot fail. The devil is a liar, and a defeated foe (1 Cor. 2:6, Col. 2:15, Phil. 2:9-11). He cannot prevent the Word of God from reaching my son.

Father, Your Word will not return to You void, but it will accomplish that which pleases You.⁴ I believe You have heard my prayer and have granted my request.⁵ I am rejoicing with confidence, knowing that You are at work in my son's life, both to will and to do Your good pleasure.⁶ Thank You, Father, that my child is saved according to Acts 16:31. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praying in the Spirit for Your Son:

God, I've prayed in English (Jas. 4:2, 1 Cor. 14:15) and I've prayed Your Word from Ephesians 1 & 3 and the 91st Psalm over my son. You said in Romans 8:26-28: **Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what *is* the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will* of God. And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose.**

Father God, I'm going to pray now in the spirit and I trust the Holy Spirit that utterance will be given me of what to pray for my son.

Put in some time praying in the Holy Ghost so the Lord can perfect all that concerns your son (Ps.138:8). Don't ever neglect your spiritual responsibilities, especially over your child. Your son's life may depend on these prayers and what you speak over him, as well as say about him. Never let any doubt or unbelief come out of your mouth after you've prayed in faith for him. So, be persistent and relentless in prayer and in speaking back to the devil and taking authority over Satan.

Additional Scriptures to Believe God for Your Son

Who shall tell thee words, whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved. **Acts 11:14**

...Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. **Acts 16:31**

Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. **Eph. 6:1-3**

The LORD shall increase you more and more, you and your children. **Psalms 115:14**

Lo, children *are* an heritage of the LORD: *and* the fruit of the womb *is his* reward. As arrows *are* in the hand of a mighty man; so *are* children of the youth. Happy *is* the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate. **Psalms 127:3-5**

For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring: **Isaiah 44:3**

But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children. **Isaiah 49:25**

And all thy children *shall be* taught of the LORD; and great *shall be* the peace of thy children. **Isaiah 54:13**

Lift up thine eyes round about, and see: all they gather themselves together, they come to thee: thy sons shall come from far, and thy daughters shall be nursed at *thy* side. **Isaiah 60:4**

Thus saith the LORD; Refrain thy voice from weeping, and thine eyes from tears: for thy work shall be rewarded, saith the LORD; and they shall come again from the land of the enemy. And there is hope in thine end, saith the LORD, that thy children shall come again to their own border. **Jeremiah 31:16,17**
